

Course I *Introduction to Orthodox Theology* [In Person]

Description

The Christian East draws on centuries-old sources for its teaching. How does the Orthodox Church understand theology and Tradition? What are the basic teachings of the Ecumenical Councils? What is the Orthodox understanding of salvation? The aforementioned topics are some of those included in this course, which serves as an introduction to Orthodox dogmatic theology.

The Very Reverend Doctor Maxym Lysack is the Pastor of Christ the Saviour Orthodox Church in Ottawa. He holds one undergraduate degree in Ukrainian language and literature, and a second in theology. He completed a Th.M. in patristics and dogmatic theology at Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology and a Ph.D. in Orthodox Theology at Laval University. He is Adjunct Professor at Saint Paul University, where he teaches courses in Eastern Christian Studies.
